Our summer camp is held at the Bridgewater-Raynham Regional High School, Bridgewater, MA. Dates and times listed below:

SESSION II: July 15 – August 2

Camp runs 9:00am – 4:00pm, Monday - Friday

- ❖ Instructor teaches OR Assistant teaches 3 Creative Computing Classes
 - 2 Classes w/ kids ages 7-9; 1 class w/ages 10-12
 - ❖ One computer class produces our camp newsletter!
 - ❖ Instructor/Assistant instructor also offers creative computing *workshops, taught twice daily* (**one** lesson plan duplicated in the afternoon)
 - ❖ Creative Computing Workshops designed to be executed in one, 45 minute period VS Computer Classes that offer projects spanning 2, or 3 days
 - ❖ Each creative computing class app. 50 minutes long
 - ❖ Class size limited to 16
 - ❖ Instructor has one planning period off each day
 - ❖ Creative computing classes offer fun projects such as creating music & artwork; blogging, writing stories w/illustrations, design of video games, etc.
 - ❖ Our youngest classes introduced to basic computer skills, then begin the creative work!
 - ❖ Lesson Plans Session I can be duplicated for Session II
