Camp runs 9:00am – 4:00pm, Monday - Friday

 - 2 Classes w/ kids ages 7-9; 1 class w/ages 10-12
- ❖ Instructor designs one arts Workshop each day, offered twice daily (**Workshop Art Projects** designed to be executed in one, 45 minute session vs Art **Classes** that offer **projects** spanning 2, 3, or 4 days)
- ❖ Each core art class app. 50 minute long
- ❖ Class size limited to 16
- ❖ Instructor has one planning period each day
- ❖ Generous art supplies provided
- ❖ Ceramics experience a plus!

Instructors design lessons in a variety of mediums for the 3 week session; our visual arts students often work with: paints, clay, ink, pastels (oil, chalk), pencils, charcoal, sculpture, collage, mask, print-making & other craft materials
